Dear Parents and Caregivers,

I start the newsletter with a reminder about tummy bugs. There is a pretty bad one doing the rounds at the moment and while we hope we have seen the worst of it, we are still seeing students and staff affected. We would ask that you keep your child home for at least 24 hours after being sick or having diarrhoea for the last time. That is the only way we can hope to limit the spread of the illness.

With the changing weather, it is a timely reminder about a few things that make life easier for children during the school day:

- a change of clothes in the bag in the event of a muddy play time
- weather appropriate footwear
- a jacket for a warm layer to go outside
- checking your child's asthma inhaler and that they have it at school for when they need it
